In the chakra system, seven represents the complete energy system of human consciousness. In Christianity, seven symbolizes divine perfection and completion. In Islam, seven represents the levels of heaven. That a three-year-old child would spontaneously choose this specific number, and count the flowers deliberately, points to a consciousness operating from divine knowledge rather than childish whim [7].

The act of offering flowers itself represents the ancient spiritual practice of surrender and devotion. In Hindu tradition, the offering of flowers (pushpanjali) symbolizes the offering of one's heart, the blossoming of devotion, and the fragrance of pure love. That Lalita instinctively engaged in this sacred act demonstrates her natural alignment with divine protocol, suggesting an innate understanding of spiritual relationship that could only come from direct experience [8].
