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# ESCHATOLOGY: #5: "until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled." The End Times is the Age that has Come ...

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# The End Times is the Age that has Come when through the Paraclete Shri Mataji "they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory." The message of the Savior is both a live telecast and a daily experience, period. (February 19, 2021)

After a two-week break, it was a bit of a struggle to get back.

First, I was cut off from HALF THE SKY because my Samsung S6 fell from the sofa and went into a permanent digital coma. Secondly, I had to prepare some heavy-duty documents for personal reasons that taxed me, both mentally and physically.

These two weeks were quite 'empty' in the sense that I was not connected to the comfort of the Resurrection and peace of the End Times, busy as I was with the world of Mormon. I was struggling to stay focussed and blissed. I was caught up again in this world of Maya (Illusion and impermanence).

Yesterday I told Sunshine that it is going to take some time adjusting to the return to HALF THE SKY.

Today I did not know where to start. Then my mind began to focus on the word "pestilence", and I know for a fact that never in human history was the world affected by a disease on the scale of Covid-19. The Black Death, Ebola, SARS, and MERS cannot be compared to Covid-19 on the scale of worldwide infection. Far from it.

But Jesus spoke of pestilence in Luke 21, but it was not fitting the chronology of the End Times. That made me uncomfortable because I cannot be talking about "until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled" and there is no mention of pestilences.

I looked up Luke 21 again. Then something caught my eye, and I was taken aback: Jesus was talking of the pestilences in the Age that has Come! He was specifically talking about the future when his disciples asked, "Teacher, when will these things happen? And what will be the sign that they are about to take place?"

### The Widow's Offering

21 As Jesus looked up, he saw the rich putting their gifts into the temple treasury. 2 He also saw a poor widow put in two very small copper coins. 3 "Truly I tell you," he said, "this poor widow has put in more than all the others. 4 All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on."

#### The Destruction of the Temple and Signs of the End Times

5 Some of his disciples were remarking about how the temple was adorned with beautiful stones and with gifts dedicated to God. but Jesus said, 6 "As for what you see here, the time will come when not one stone will be left on another; every one of them will be thrown down."

7 "Teacher," they asked, "when will these things happen? And what will be the sign that they are about to take place?" 8 He replied: "Watch out that you are not deceived. For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am he,' and, 'The time is near.' Do not follow them. 9 When you hear of wars and uprisings, do not be frightened. These things must happen first, but the end will not come right away."

### Jesus Foretells Wars and Persecution

10 Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. 11 There will be great earthquakes, and in various places famines and pestilences. And there will be terrors and great signs from

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heaven. 12 <u>But before all this</u> they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake. [emphasis ours]

#### Luke 21:1-12

Jesus speaks of the future when he says, "But before all this" i.e., before that future Age to Come "they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake." And that is exactly what happened to his disciples 2000 years ago in the Age that Was (but we will not go into those historical details).

Is the coronavirus then a sign of the End Times? I have extracted this article:

## Coronavirus: Is it mentioned in Bible prophecy?

In Luke chapter 21, Jesus speaks prophetically about the signs that would precede the end of the world. In Luke 21:11, Jesus says that one of those signs would be pestilences, "And there will be great earthquakes in various places, and famines and pestilences; and there will be fearful sights and great signs from heaven." (The meaning of a pestilence, according to the Hebrew and Greek definitions, is a plague or disease.)

Additionally, in Matthew 24:7-8 (NASB) Jesus says, "For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and in various places there will be famines and earthquakes. But all these things are merely the beginning of birth pangs." In several versions of the Bible the word "pestilences" appears between famines and earthquakes.

### Frequency and severity

In the prophetic Bible verses above, Jesus was referring to a baby's birth. He was explaining that just as a woman's contractions or labor pains get more frequent and severe as a baby is nearing birth, so these events or signs will also become more frequent and severe as the world nears the second coming of Jesus.

#### Is the coronavirus a sign of the end?

Since Jesus mentioned pestilences, does this mean that the coronavirus has been predicted as the sign that the world will end and Jesus will come back tomorrow? Probably not.

Throughout history many plagues and diseases have caused fear and death. For example, consider the following outbreaks:

The Black Death Ebola SARS MERS Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Jesus didn't come back in the past because of these plagues. However, as epidemics including the coronavirus occur more often and become more deadly, we should pay attention as these are warning signs that Jesus is coming back soon.

The main point of what Jesus is saying in Luke 21 and Matthew 24 is to watch for the prophetic signs to increase in frequency. This increase will signal the imminent coming of Jesus.
