Hi everyone,

I am honored by the simultaneous grace of Kiran and Aleja on this HALF THE SKY chat.

All these weeks I did not realize that Aleja had not been included all along. My original "I want to awaken Lalita and Aleja" desire will now be "I want to awaken Lalita, Aleja, and Kiran."
